

# Build a Bulletin Board About Internet Safety

**Goal:** Create a bulletin board to demonstrate Internet security tips/messages.

**Materials:** Bulletin board materials such as construction paper, paint, markers, etc.

## Instructions:

- As a class, have students brainstorm Internet safety tips learned in the i-SAFE lessons.
- Create a title for the bulletin board such as “Taking the right road on the Cyberspace Highway” or “Traveling Safely in Cyberspace,” etc.
- Have students conduct an Internet search for “road signs” or “street signs” to get roadway sign ideas.
- Assign each student or student group a road sign.
- Students create a selection of traffic signs that relate an Internet security tip or message. See example below.
- Create a background for the bulletin board that depicts the students’ idea of the Cyberspace Highway.
- Cut out the completed signs and place on the board.
- Embellish with people, computers, Internet places/Web sites, etc.
